#### Methodology

### The aim of this research is to generate PR-able findings to support Ford's service-oriented campaign around Valentine's Day. PSB conducted 1,253 online interviews with hospitality workers




1. Hospitality workers think Valentine's Day is one of the best holidays to work on







Those in a relationship are more likely to say not celebrating with loved ones is the biggest drawback about working on Valentine's Day











Thinking in general, do you usually <u>celebrate Valentine's Day</u> with your partner or spouse?




