## HIGHLIGHTS

- Ford sold more than $\mathbf{1 . 3 5}$ million vehicles in 2018 in its traditional European 20 markets*, reaching 7.6 percent market share
- Ford is Europe's No. 1 commercial vehicle brand for the fourth consecutive year, based on full year 2018 sales in its European 20 markets
- Ford delivered its best commercial vehicle sales volume in 25 years, selling 380,900 commercial vehicles in its European 20 markets in 2018, up more than 8 percent compared with 2017. Market share grew 0.6 percentage points last year to 14.1 percent in Ford's European 20 markets, its highest level since 1995.
- Ford SUV sales rose $\mathbf{1 9 . 3}$ percent in 2018, growing to 275,100 vehicles, based on the strength of Kuga and EcoSport
- Kuga and EcoSport each had their best years ever, with Kuga sales reaching 153,800 and EcoSport hitting 111,700 sales in Ford's European 20 markets in 2018. High demand for Ford EcoSport continues with December, with orders growing 55 percent versus December 2017
- High-series models (including Titanium, Vignale, Active, ST-line, ST and RS) comprised more than $\mathbf{7 0}$ percent of Ford's passenger car sales in its traditional European markets, reflecting an increase of 5.1 percentage points
- Retail and fleet customer sales accounted for 74.1 percent of Ford passenger vehicle sales in the brand's top five European markets in 2018, beating the industry average

## VEHICLEAND MARKET NEWS



EcoSport sales grew 78 percent in 2018 compared with 2017, making last year the best ever for EcoSport in Ford's European 20 markets. Orders in December were up 55 percent versus the same month in 2017.


Ford was the UK's No. 1 brand in 2018, achieving its 42nd straight year of new passenger car sales leadership, and 53rd consecutive year of commercial vehicle sales leadership. Ford also led the market for the ninth time in Hungary.


Successful line-up: In 2018, Ford's commercial vehicle business recorded its best performance in 25 years. With a market share of 14.1 percent in its European 20 markets, Ford became Europe's No. 1 CV brand for the fourth year in a row.
